Later Hunter Douglas hired him to be a consultant to aid them in the implementation of a new LMS product.

Throughout the years Troy has worked as a consultant with KOAA, as well in the healthcare field for Sangre de Cristo Hospice where he designed and developed the complete corporate IS/IT infrastructure for their four-city, five location system.
